Dr. Bozena Wrobel is an Associate Professor of Otolaryngology and Neurosurgery at USC. She graduated from Medical University of Warsaw and completed a residency in Otolaryngology-HNS at University of Colorado. She completed a one-year Fellowship in Rhinology & Chemosensory Disorders at the University of Nebraska with Dr. Donald Leopold. Dr. Wrobel did a post-doctorate fellowship on Endoscopic Approaches to Anterior Skull Base with Prof PJ Wormald, Adelaide University, South Australia.

Dr. Wrobel's medical practice is limited to Complex Rhinology and Anterior Endoscopic Skull Base surgery. She is internationally recognized expert surgeon in endoscopic surgical approaches to Frontal Sinus (Lothrop) and Anterior Skull Base Surgery. She is Division Chief of Rhinology and Anterior Endoscopic Skull Base Surgery at USC. Her research includes chemosensory disorders, endoscopic skull base approaches, and development of a carotid injury simulation training model and CSF leak repair training model.

Dr. Wrobel has been Course Director of the USC Advanced Endoscopic Sinus Surgery (ESS) Courses (now biannual) for the past 13 years. In 2008, she organized at USC a "Hands-On" Skull Base Surgery Course (now biannual) with Prof PJ Wormald. She also organized an International "Hands-On" ESS Course in Kajetany, Poland. Dr. Wrobel has been an "Invited Guest Speaker" in Rhinology on Advanced ESS and Skull Base Surgery in Mexico, Canada and Poland.

Dr. Wrobel is Chairman of International Liaisons Committee of the American Rhinologic Society (ARS), and she is on the Editorial Board of the American Journal of Rhinology and Allergy. She is Past-President of LA Society of Otolaryngology.
