



Kathleen Yaremchuk, MD MSA is President of the American Academy of Otolaryngology-Head and Neck Surgery. She is a Professor at Wayne State University School of Medicine Department of Otolaryngology-Head and Neck Surgery and a Professor at Michigan State University College of Human Medicine Office of the Dean. She is Chair of Otolaryngology & Head and Neck Surgery at Henry Ford Health and the first female to serve as the Chair of the Henry Ford Medical Group Board of Governors. Dr. Yaremchuk served as Chair of the Henry Ford Health System Quality and Safety Committee and was the first physician to do so.

Dr. Yaremchuk has received the Jerome C. Goldstein, MD Award for Public Service. She served as President of the Women in Otolaryngology (WIO) and received the Helen F. Krause, MD Trailblazer Award from WIO for leadership in mentoring and advocating for women in otolaryngology. She has previously served on AAO/HNS Board of Directors.

Dr. Yaremchuk is board certified in Otolaryngology-Head and Neck Surgery and Sleep Medicine. She has served as Chair of the Sleep Disorders Committee for AAO/HNS and has served as a moderator and panelist on an FDA task force regarding sleep disordered breathing and as a representative to the American Association of Sleep Medicine as a spokesperson for Otolaryngology and Sleep Medicine. Dr. Yaremchuk is currently treasurer for the International Surgical Sleep Society. She has authored multiple original research papers, book chapters and a text books, and has been an invited lecturer nationally and internationally on Sleep Medicine and Surgery.
