

Dr Jeffrey Koempel has served as the Division Chief of Pediatric Otolaryngology at the Childrens' Hospital Los Angeles (CHLA) since 2014 and is an Associate Professor at the Keck School of Medicine of the University of Southern California in Los Angeles. He is also the Program Director for the pediatric otolaryngology fellowship at CHLA.

Dr. Koempel received both undergraduate and graduate medical degrees from Georgetown University in Washington, DC. He completed otolaryngology residency at the Eye and Ear Infirmary at the University of Illinois at Chicago and a pediatric otolaryngology fellowship under the direction of Lauren Holinger at the Children's Memorial Hospital, now Lurie Children's Hospital, in Chicago.

In 2005, Dr Koempel completed a healthcare MBA program at the Paul Merage School of Business of the University of California at Irvine where he graduated first in his class.

Dr. Koempel's research has focused on thyroglossal duct and tonsil surgery. He has delivered more than 100 presentations nationally and internationally on a variety of pediatric otolaryngology topics and business of medicine issues.
